## FATHER SHANE CAMPBELL

Today we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord. Jesus was not baptized to be set free from original sin, but rather to transform the Old Covenant into a New Covenant. The Baptism of Jesus is also the acceptance of His mission as the Messiah. In the waters of the Jordan, Jesus is anointed, by John the Baptist, with the Holy Spirit and is thus revealed to be the eternal Son of God.

Finally, by accepting Baptism from John, the Lord Jesus is also accepting and anticipating His own suffering and death. For this reason, each Christian is united to the death of the Lord Jesus through Baptism so that we can live the life of the new creation by grace through faith in Jesus the Christ.

All of this makes our Baptism the single most important event in our entire lives; it is the original sacrament of faith and the beginning of the life of grace. But unless we understand the meaning of this gift, we risk misunderstanding the whole of the Christian life. For this reason, parents and godparents have the sacred duty to teach children who are baptized about the day of their Baptism and lead them to mature faith in Jesus Christ.

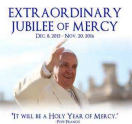
