#### FROM THE PAST

Dear Parishioners-

A thought came to me in prayer last Wednesday morning. Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. Jesus would not allow himself to be driven by the devil, but led by the Holy Spirit. So often, we can find ourselves pressured to make a decision that could affect a number of people in our lives, either good or bad. It has occurred to me that we all must be led by the Spirit of God in our decision making process. This would involve prayer, perhaps gathering more information from other sources, and even fasting. I have to come to see the importance of this in my own life. If you come to me with a request, I hope you will understand, that I will come to a decision, but I may need some time for prayer, fasting, and consultation. It is not meant to come off as indecisive, but to make a better decision for all. I hope you will understand that I may need to employ this method from time to time.

Speaking of prayer, the next several Wednesdays of Lent, beginning March 13, 5:30-8:30 p.m., there will be Eucharistic Adoration along with some very brief talks to explain this form of prayer. If you never tried this before, I would challenge you to step out in faith with this form of prayer. It has the potential to bring much spiritual fruit to your life. Please prayerfully consider this practice during the Lenten Season.
