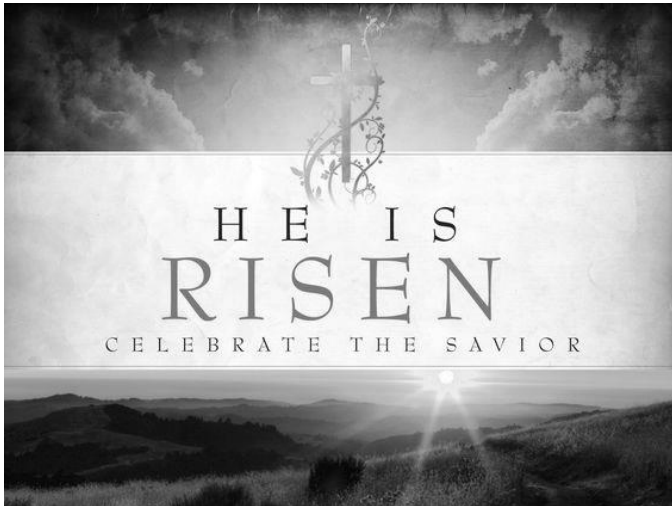
Partner-in-Faith Prayer

BROKEN FOR US

"Jesus was broken; he is broken for us. And he asks us to give ourselves, to break ourselves, as it were for others. This 'breaking bread' became the icon, the sign for recognizing Christ and Christians. From the outset it is the Eucharist which becomes the center and pattern of the life of the Church. How many mothers, how many fathers, together with the slices of bread they provide each day on the tables of their homes, have broken their hearts to let their children grow, and grow well! Where do they find the strength to do this? It is in the Eucharist: in the power of the Risen Lord's love, who today too breaks bread for us and repeats: 'Do this in remembrance of me.'"
