## SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

### Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

We, as a parish, were elated to welcome new members at last Thursday's Mass celebrating the Feast of St. Andrew. Providing a warm welcome to our new parishioners is one of the most prominent characteristics of our parish community. A warm welcome is also part of evangelization, a work necessary in the church's mission to help people discover or renew their faith in Christ. It is important for us to reflect on how we treat others. Remember, we are Christ's ambassadors. Our actions and reactions toward visitors at Mass communicate who we are and who we represent. Let us take time to welcome all visitors and guests who come and worship with us, especially during this Advent and Christmas season.

Advent is intended to be a season of preparation for Christ's first coming in the manger at Bethlehem and for His return at the "Parousia" or second coming at the end of time. While we typically regard Advent as a joyous occasion, it is also a period of preparation, much like Lent. Prayer, penance and fasting are appropriate during this season. It is most worthy to do these religious acts as we prepare ourselves for the birth of the Messiah.

In today's Gospel, we hear the story of St. John the Baptist, a "voice crying out in the wilderness." The people flocked to him and listened to his message. This does not happen anymore. Although amazing technological inventions have made communications faster and easier, it has also brought in more noise, distractions and confusion. The truth is muffled and the facts are subjected to manipulations and distortions. Worst of all, the voice of God is drowned and rendered irrelevant and ineffective in the world. The image of St. John the Baptist is presented to remind us of two things. First, we need to heed his call to repentance with seriousness and urgency. Second, we need to become like St. John the Baptist. As Christians, it is our duty to continually remind ourselves and other people about this and to help lead them to repentance and conversion. We are called to be like John the Baptist.

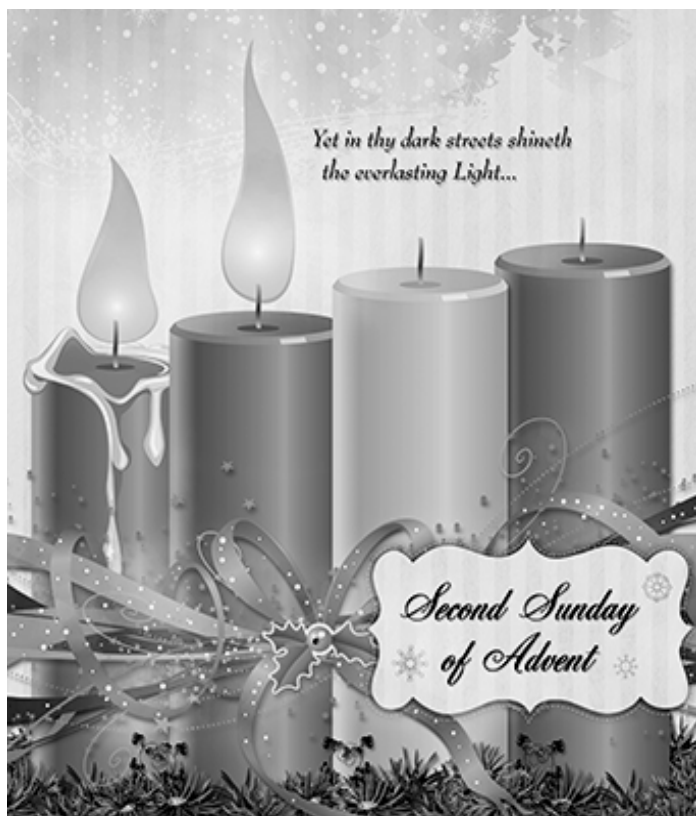
