## LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I just checked our current DSF 2018 report and found that we are still \$22,000 .00 short in reaching our mandatory goal this year in payments and another \$12,104.00 below even in reaching our pledge goal( with 100 less contributors than last year). The Diocese just sent out another mailing to remind those who have not given to please do so. Have you made your pledge to DSF yet? Now is the time to do so. Please help us so we don't have to keep reminding you over and over. The end of the year is less than 4 months away.

As far as the loan to finish paying off our new Parish Activity Center, we just converted the construction loan to a 1 year fixed loan with the Archdiocese with interest of 3.1% interest with a balloon for the balance in the amount of \$1.9 M. Keep up your support of your pledges and promises on the third Sunday " Hand in Hand fund". Substantial donors will be remembered by name on the beautiful Giving Tree in the Activity Center lobby. Also have you considered putting St. Jerome building Fund or St. Jerome School in your last will?. I did and you can too.

Two big events recently in the Center are FTCM," Formation Toward Christian Ministry" held on Thursdays. Over 150 (mostly parishioners) paid \$50. 00 each to attend these great scriptural classes in spanish for 15 weeks, and Saturday evening the Christian Family Movement met in the Activity Center with a huge crowd of over 500 members to start the new year.

Fall Festival is just two weeks away. Sell those great raffle tickets and make your donation to make this Festival the best ever.

A word now about this Sunday. Critics of the Catholic Church sometimes say that our traditions, rituals, and sacraments take away this person-to-person dimension of our relationship with God. They say that we should just "go directly to God," instead of using intermediaries such as priests, the Mass, confession, and traditional prayers. But this is a false argument, for two reasons. First, because the Church does in fact, encourage us to "go directly" to God, all the time, as often as we can! Here's how Pope Benedict XVI put it in a speech to youth in New York, in April 2008: "What matters most is that you develop your personal relationship with God." The Church doesn't discourage us from having a personal relationship with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ - on the contrary!

The second reason this is a false argument has to do with the reason behind the sacraments, rituals, and traditions. When we understand them properly and live them sincerely, they actually help us encounter God more personally. In fact, that's why the Holy Spirit invented them - precisely to give us more opportunities to experience God's closeness in a personal, tangible way. When we confess our sins to a priest in the sacrament of reconciliation, for example, it is a personal encounter, a truly human encounter in which God assures us of his forgiveness in the most down-to-earth way possible. And when we receive Holy Communion, once again Jesus is making himself tangible, nearer than we could ever make him all by ourselves. The Church is God's gift to us, full of instruments that he uses to reach out to us in ways that we can see, hear, and touch. Today let's thank God for taking such a personal interest in each one of us, and let's promise never again to take for granted this most important relationship of our lives.

Por favor ayúdenos para que no le tengamos que seguir recordando una y otra vez. El fin del año está a menos de 4 meses.

En cuanto al préstamo para terminar de pagar nuestro nuevo centro de actividad de la parroquia, el préstamo de construcción se ha fijado para un 1 año con la Arquidiócesis con interés de 3.1% con un global para el equilibrio en la cantidad de 1,9 M. mantenga su apoyo y su promesa cada tercer domingo de "En el fondo de mano a mano". Importantes donantes serán recordados poniendo su nombre en el hermoso árbol del pasillo en el centro de actividades. ¿También ha considerado poner algún fondo para el edificio o la escuela de San Jerónimo en su testamento? Yo ya lo hice y usted también puede Hacerlo. Dos recientes y grandes eventos en el centro son FTCM, "formación para Ministerio Cristiano" celebrada el jueves. Más 150 (sobre todo los feligreses) pagaron \$50. 00 cada uno para asistir a estas excelentes clases Bíblicas en español por 15 semanas y el sábado por la noche el movimiento familiar cristiano se reúne en el centro de actividades con una multitud de más de 500 miembros para comenzar el nuevo año.

¡Festival de otoño es de sólo dos semanas! Venda los boletos de la gran rifa y haga su donación para hacer de este Festival mejor que nunca. Unas palabras ahora sobre este domingo. Los críticos de la iglesia católica a veces dicen que nuestras tradiciones, rituales y sacramentos no quitan esta dimensión personal de nuestra relación con Dios. Dicen que debemos sólo "ir directamente a Dios," en lugar de utilizar intermediarios como los sacerdotes, la Misa, confesión y oraciones tradicionales. Pero esto es un argumento falso, por dos razones. En primer lugar, porque la Iglesia de hecho, nos anima a "ir directamente" a Dios, todo el tiempo, tan a menudo como nos sea posible! Así es cómo el Papa Benedicto XVI lo puso en un discurso a la juventud en Nueva York, en abril de 2008: "lo más importante es que desarrolles tu relación personal con Dios". La iglesia no nos desalienta de tener una relación personal con nuestro Señor y Salvador, Jesucristo - por el contrario! La segunda razón es un argumento falso que tiene que ver con el motivo de los sacramentos, rituales y tradiciones. Cuando se entienden correctamente y los vives sinceramente, realmente nos ayudan a encontrar más personalmente a Dios. De hecho, es por eso que el Espíritu Santo las inventó - precisamente para darnos más oportunidades de experimentar la cercanía de Dios de manera personal, tangible. Cuando confesamos nuestros pecados a un sacerdote en el Sacramento de la reconciliación, por ejemplo, es un encuentro personal, un encuentro verdaderamente humano en el cual Dios nos asegura su perdón en la forma más sencilla. De la manera más sencilla posible. Y cuando recibimos la Sagrada comunión, una vez más Jesús está haciéndose tangible, más cerca de lo que lo podríamos hacer por nosotros mismos. La iglesia es un don de Dios para nosotros, llena de instrumentos que utiliza para llegar a nosotros de manera

que podemos ver, oír y tocar. Hoy vamos a dar gracias a Dios por tomar tal personal interés en cada uno de nosotros y vamos a prometer nunca más a dar por sentado esta relación más importante de nuestras vidas.

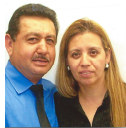
