There are two options available when you register – one is with an overnight stay and the second is for those who would like to commute. The cost : (all rooms have two queen beds)

- Single Occupancy: \$120
- Double Occupancy: \$80
- Triple Occupancy: \$65
- Quadruple Occupancy: \$60
- Commuter Rate: \$40

Deadline for these prices is March 1st. After that there is an additional \$20 added on and rooms will be given on a first come, first serve basis. **All registrations are due by March 8th.**
