THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

Almighty ever-living God, increase our faith, hope and charity, and make us love what You command, so that we may merit what You promise. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Today's Mass Readings

1st reading: Jeremiah 31:7-9

2nd reading: Hebrews 5:1-6

Gospel: Mark 10:46-52

At times it can seem all but impossible to believe that things will get better, but God does bring back the exiles (whether they be the exiles in Babylon or our exiled hearts that have been broken). The restoration does not always come in the way we had hoped, but it always comes in the way that we need.

Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 126:1-6

The Responsorial Psalm continues the theme of restoration found in the First Reading. It speaks of the experience God's people who were brought back from exile.

They had been carried off to a foreign land weeping, but now they were being fully restored. Even the nations, the pagan peoples, could see what God was doing for them.

The third section of the psalm changes from what seems to be past events (even if they do not seem to be events of the distant past) to present entreaties. The Psalmist beseeches the Lord to continue his beneficence and restore the fortunes of his people.

If he had already done so much for them bringing them back from all the lands to which they had been scattered, then certainly he could complete his work by blessing their enterprises with success.

We often pray to God this way, recalling how God has led us through difficulties in the past, and asking God to do so once again we are in need.
