BLESSING OF EPIPHANY CHALK

It is traditional for parish priests to bless chalk on the Epiphany. The chalk is taken home and is used to mark the year and the initials of the three Magi (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar) over the door of the house to remind all who enter and leave through the main door that they also must be ready to leave all, if necessary, and follow Christ. It might be added also that this is a beautiful act of faith.
