Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord

On the threshold of the public life: the Baptism; on the threshold of the Passover: the Transfiguration. Jesus' Baptism proclaimed the mystery of the first regeneration, namely, our Baptism; the Transfiguration is the sacrament of the second regeneration: our own Resurrection. From now on we share in the Lord's Resurrection through the Spirit who acts in the sacraments of the Body of Christ. The Transfiguration not only gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body, but also recalls that it is through many persecutions that we will enter the kingdom of God" (CCC, 556). Without the eyes of our heart focused on the light manifest through the Gospel, while we may physically rise, we could slumber in action. Christ helps us to rise and to not be afraid. The transformative

power of Christ helps to steady us on the path to everlasting life, in spite of the challenging difficulties that may be encountered in relationships, work, and society.
