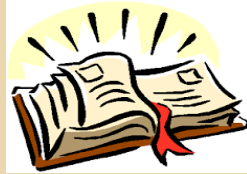
First Reading

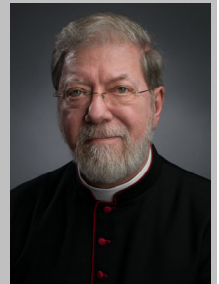

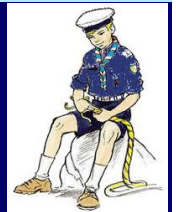

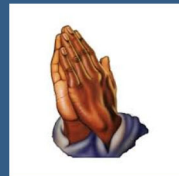
