Participants will receive weekly email or text reminders to pray and fast, along with little known facts about *Roe v. Wade* to share with others.

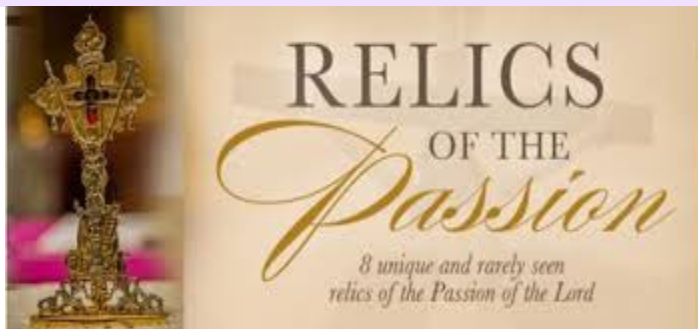
Please join Catholics nation-wide and sign up at www.usccb.org/pray. You can also use KC Council 3015 novena available in the narthex.

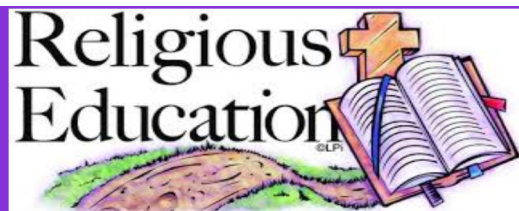

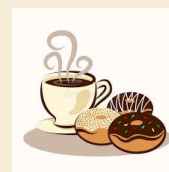

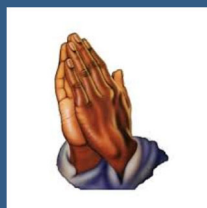
