PROVINCIAL'S VISIT - next weekend, from Friday, October 16th through Sunday, October 18th, our Provincial, Very Rev. William (Bill) Harry, O. Carm. will be here for a formal visitation with the Carmelites, and a pastoral visit in our parishes. He will be in Leavenworth earlier in the week. Fr. Bill will preside and preach at both Parish Masses next weekend, and is looking forward to meeting and visiting with the parish communities of Richmond and Scipio. To facilitate this, there will be a social following the weekend Masses. On Saturday evening, following the 6 PM Mass, we will gather in St. Therese church basement for a "meet and greet", with light refreshments. Following the 9 AM Mass on Sunday morning, Fr. Bill will bless the new Hermitages, and, weather permitting, refreshments will be served in front of the Priory - or in the Parish Hall if the weather does not cooperate. Anyone who would like to add to the refreshment tables is most welcome to do so. I know Fr. Bill is looking forward to his time here - and I'm sure you will offer him your customary welcome and hospitality!

NEW LITURGICAL CALENDARS HAVE ARRIVED - The Liturgical Calendars for 2016 have arrived, and I am now able to start scheduling Masses for the coming year. **Some things to keep in mind:** Mass requests must be made in writing, or made in person at the parish office at the Priory. If you try to reach me on the phone for a Mass, please just leave a message and a phone number and I will return your call for the details. Please **do not** leave the Mass intention information on the answering machine. Written requests may be left in the Offertory basket. Masses for a given date are on a first come, first served basis. If you want a Mass on a particular day, make your request sooner rather than later. To be fair to other parishioners, I will only accept 2 (two) Mass intentions from an individual or a family for Saturday evening or Sunday Masses until February 29, 2016. After that date, I will do my best to honor additional requests for weekend Masses. **No Mass offerings or intentions** will be taken for Christmas Eve or Christmas Day, New Years' Eve or New Years' Day, Holy Thursday (March 24th), Easter Vigil or Easter Sunday (March 26th & 27th), Mothers' Day weekend (May 7th & 8th), Fathers' Day weekend (June 18th & 19th), or Thanksgiving Day (November 24th). Mass stipends (\$10) may be made in cash, or by check made out to St. Boniface or St. Therese - not to Frs. Jerry or Dave. Thanks!
