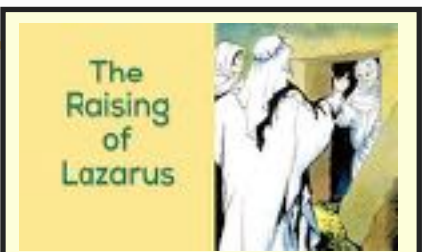

Holy Week and Easter Scheduling

Palm Sunday, April 9th - Regular weekend Mass schedule and Communal Reconciliation Service with individual Confessions at St. Boniface at 5:00 PM; NO MORNING MASS at St. Therese on Tuesday, April 11th; Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper at St. Therese at 5:00 PM with Adoration until 10:00 PM, and at St. Boniface at 7:00 PM, with Adoration until 10:30 PM; Good Friday - St. Therese at 3:00 PM, and at St. Boniface at 7:00 PM. Holy Saturday - NO Confessions, Blessing of Easter Foods at Noon at St. Boniface; Easter Vigil at St. Boniface ONLY at 7:30 PM. Easter Sunday - Sunrise Service in the Cemetery (weather permitting) at 6:20 AM; Mass at St. Therese at 7:30 AM, and Mass at St. Boniface at 9:00 AM followed by the Easter Egg Hunt for the children.
