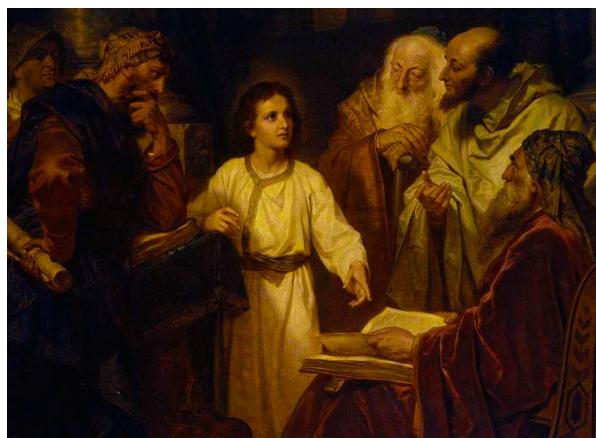

## Pastoral Staff

My dear St. Mary, Star of the Sea family,

As much as it pains me to say this, the time has come to say farewell to a family God graciously invited me to be a part of. G.K. Chesterton once said, “family is the theater of the spiritual drama, the place where things happen, especially the things that matter.” This is exactly what I experienced. When I was informed by Fr. Richard McNeillie, Director of Vocations, that I was assigned for the semester to St. Mary, Star of the Sea, I had no clue where it was and what to expect. I knew it was the furthest parish south in the Archdiocese. Little did I know the marvelous treasure that awaited me here: a loving community and above all, a *family*. The essence of my experience at this loving parish can be summed up as *an encounter with Christ in a loving and welcoming family*.

When I first arrived in August, I noticed immediately the way Fr. Jesse welcomed me with embracing arms to a community he so fervently loves. I discerned the way he welcomed me reflected the exact way the community welcomed me. The pastor and the community synchronized in Christ, in *loving unity*, welcoming those visitors who come by.

Having recognized the unity so ingrained in the hospitality of the community, I was blessed to be involved in various ministries and activities at the parish. I am beyond blessed to have had the opportunity to teach 5<sup>th</sup> Grade CCE. I will truly miss my beloved 5<sup>th</sup> graders very much. As a Catechist, I became a student with them, learning the *beauty of discipleship*, in effect, learning the docility of a loving disciple through the “Cube of Love.” I was invited to accompany the leaders of the Movimiento Familiar Cristiano in their preparation for couple gatherings. As a witness to the married couples, I learned the *truth of unity in matrimony* embracing the missionary zeal to invite couples to embrace Christ in their marriages. I was reminded through them the love I have for marriage preparation and for the sanctification of marriages and families. God gave me the opportunity to invite young adults to gather in Jesus’s name to share the blessings and graces in our lives. As a young adult among them, I learned the *goodness of God’s love* in each of my brothers and sister’s lived experiences learning to embody the love of God in those we encounter in school, at work, everywhere. Among other ministries which I had the pleasure of being a part of were the Altar Society who fervently serve the community with their attention to our worship environment; teaching and serving with the Altar servers, who are always ready to serve the Lord and are a joyful part of the liturgy; significant to my cultural formation and fundamental to my personal roots, I had the pleasure of accompanying the Guadalupanos in their mission to spread the love of our Lady of Guadalupe in this parish. I am blessed to have experienced the phenomenal and traditional celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe here at this parish—a true cultural masterpiece under the leadership of Michael and Elsa. Thank you to all the families that took me under their wings!

However, where I witnessed the nucleus of the unity of the parish was at the parish office. Of all my experiences, I have never witnessed a loving office so unified in the love for Christ and yet so human to approach. Tina and Monica taught me the revolving beauty of St. Mary and St. Martha—always ever so ready to assist and attend to matters and yet always contemplative in their relationship with our Lord. I was blessed to have served and worked alongside Deacon Felipe, always ready to remind me of the humanity of Christ and to have a sense of humor. Brother Bill and Marilyn, brilliant Catechists, taught me the diligence in preparing disciples for our Lord with their catechetical knowledge and their love for evangelization at the parish. Valentina, house keeper of the parish, not only radiated with her smile, but shined jovially through her charity. As a student learns from his teacher, Fr. Jesse taught me the fundamental framework for a loving community in Christ through the *spirituality of communion*, where as brothers and sisters in Christ we love our neighbor so as to love God through them—ever so ready to make acts of love to embrace Christ in the other, ready to die to oneself for the other.

I cannot express in words how grateful I am to have been a part of St. Mary, Star of the Sea community. My time here at this parish is an enormous consolation to my vocational discernment and, as Mary cherished her moments with Christ, I too will keep these experiences in my heart as I continue towards my Priestly journey. Please be assured that you all will be in my prayers as I return to seminary. If possible, say a prayer for this pilgrim who wishes to serve by our Lord’s side one day at his Altar. ## De Parte de Nuestro Seminarista

## Personal Parroquial

Mi querida familia de Santa María, Estrella del Mar,

Por mucho que me duele decir esto, ha llegado el momento de despedirme de una familia a la que Dios amablemente me invitó a ser parte. G K. Chesterton dijo una vez: "la familia es el teatro del drama espiritual, el lugar donde suceden las cosas, especialmente las cosas que importan". Esto es exactamente lo que experimenté. Cuando fui informado por el Padre Richard McNeillie, Director de Vocaciones, que me asignaron durante el semestre a Santa María, Estrella del Mar, no tenía ni idea de dónde estaba y qué esperar. Una cosa que sí sabía es que era la parroquia más alejada del sur en la Arquidiócesis de Galveston-Houston. Poco sabía el maravilloso tesoro que me esperaba allí: una comunidad amorosa y, sobre todo, una familia. La esencia de mi experiencia en esta parroquia amorosa puede resumirse como *un encuentro con Cristo en una familia amorosa y acogedora*.

Me gustaría compartir mis reflexiones y experiencias desde que estoy aquí. Cuando llegué por primera vez en agosto, noté inmediatamente la forma en que el Padre Jesse me recibió con los brazos abiertos en una comunidad que tanto ama. Percibí que la forma en que me dio la bienvenida reflejaba la manera exacta en que la comunidad me recibió. El pastor y la comunidad sincronizados en Cristo, *amando en unidad*, dando la bienvenida a los visitantes que vienen.

Habiendo reconocido la unidad tan arraigada en la hospitalidad de la comunidad, tuve la bendición de participar en varios ministerios y actividades en la parroquia. Entre otros ministerios de los cuales tuve el placer de involucrarme, es la Sociedad del Altar, que sirven fervientemente a la comunidad con su atención a nuestro entorno de adoración; también enseñar y servir con los servidores del Altar, quienes siempre están listos para servir al Señor, se alegran de ser parte de la liturgia; Significativo para mi formación cultural y fundamental de mis raíces personales, tuve el placer de acompañar a los Guadalupanos en su misión de difundir el amor de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en esta parroquia. Tengo la suerte de haber experimentado la fenomenal y tradicional celebración de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe aquí en esta parroquia, una verdadera obra maestra cultural bajo el liderazgo de Michael y Elsa. ¡Gracias a todas las familias que me apoyaron!
