

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Very often the parish office receives requests from other pastors and churches asking us for a "letter of good-standing of active membership" in order that a person can be a godparent and/or a sponsor for a baptism or confirmation.

Upon these requests, I will usually write one of two letters. One will say that "this parishioner is an active, participating member." The other letter will say that "this parishioner is registered but I cannot find any evidence of active participation."

The second letter can be upsetting for some because they want me to write things which I believe are untruthful. To seek better clarification, I found four criteria that the Diocese published in order to be considered an "active, participating parishioner."

- 1. They must be registered in the parish.
- 2. They must be recognized by the Pastor as participating in the sacramental life of the parish.
- 3. They must contribute time and talent to the life of the parish.
- 4. They must regularly contribute an appropriate portion of their annual income to the financial support of the parish.

Roughly 60% of our parish cannot meet 3 out of the 4 criteria. How can one promise to sponsor a child in the Catholic faith if they are not practicing their own Catholic faith?

I hope this will help you to understand the seriousness of what it means to be a godparent or sponsor.
