- Games are 7 v 7 for JV and 8 v 8 for Varsity
- Varsity is Grades 6-8 Co-ed
- JV is Grades 3-5 Co-ed
- Games are played in Manchester on Saturdays
- First several practices (in March) will be held in the gym and school/parish campus
- Beginning in April, practice location will be **Percival Field** in Kensington

- Varsity practices will be Tuesdays and Thursdays in the 3-5pm time slot
- JV practices will be Wednesdays for March and starting in April, Mondays and Wednesdays in the 3-5pm time slot
- Students who play on another soccer team (travel, premier, etc) are welcome to play on this school team as well
- Season continues into mid-June


Please join the fun on Mother-Son Bowling Night on March 15, 2019 at Lucky Lanes! See attached flyer and reservation form for details.
