English Masses will be celebrated at **8:00 a.m.** (All School Mass) and **6:30 p.m.** A Spanish Mass will be celebrated at **8:00 p.m.**

Stations of the Cross will be held in the main church each Friday of Lent, beginning on **Friday, February 12, 2016**, at **7:00 p.m.**

LENTEN RULES require Catholics between the ages of **18 and 60** to fast on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**. In addition all Catholics **14 years of age and older** must abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.**

FASTING as explained by the U.S. Conference of Bishops means partaking of only one full meal during the day. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening, depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

ABSTINENCE forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products, or condiments made of animal fat.
