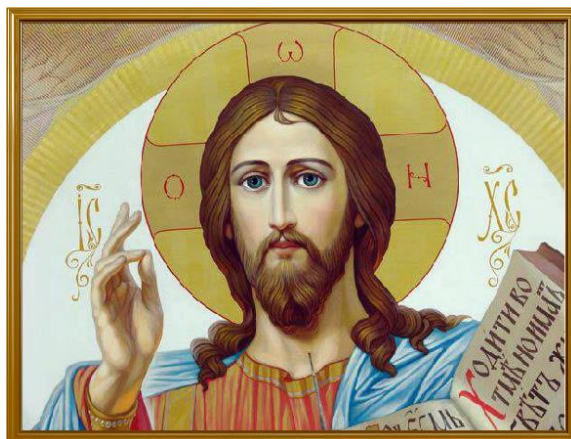

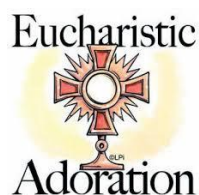
## BIBLE STUDY

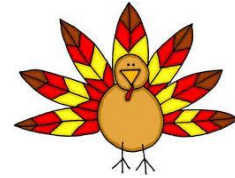
