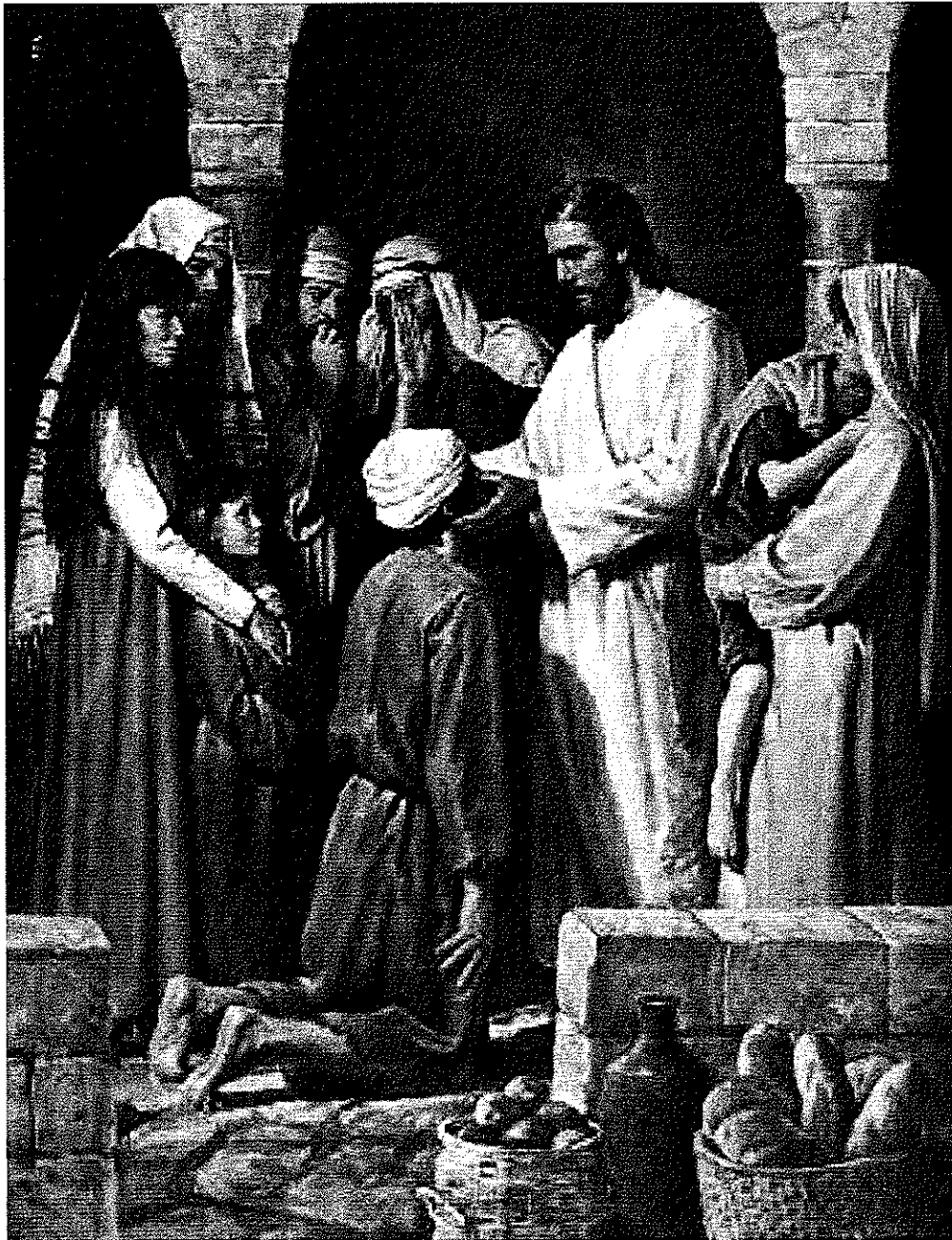

From the Desk of Mary Higgins**We Are Called to Discipleship**

On the recommendation of a friend, I went to see the movie *Risen* last weekend. It's the story of the resurrection of Jesus told from the perspective of a Roman commander who is ordered by Pilate to find the missing body to keep order in Jerusalem. It's fiction, but nevertheless a powerful movie. The transformation of the Roman tribute, from a warrior zealous in his ambition and determined to keep the Jewish people in submission under Roman authority to a believer in the resurrection, is engaging and inspiring.

I found myself paying attention to the apostles, who at first were hiding for fear of Jewish leadership and the Romans, but who eventually played a major role in the conversion of the Roman. How great was the cost of their discipleship – most of them were eventually martyred. They were frightened, ashamed of their abandonment of Jesus, confused about the next step, but also joyous in seeing Jesus truly risen. The Holy Spirit would give them the power to carry on Jesus' mission and build the early Church, despite all the challenges of unbelief, mistrust, and persecution. Ultimately, they offered their lives to a mission greater than themselves.

We have heard that we are all called to be disciples, to pick up our crosses and follow Jesus. We might also feel frightened of the cost, ashamed of our sins and failings, and confused about what exactly it means to be a disciple of Jesus in the 21st century. In the words of author Sherry Weddell: "Twenty-first-century people process issues of faith differently than earlier generations did. They usually don't become disciples in a single step. Instead, they typically pass through a series of "thresholds" or stages of conversion before they are ready to consciously follow Jesus Christ as a disciple in the midst of his Church. Each transition to a new threshold is a genuine work of grace that is empowered by the Holy Spirit but moving into each threshold is also a deliberate choice. "Conversion" for post-moderns is typically an ever-increasing commitment to a deeper and deeper "yes."

The New Prague Area Catholic Community staff and leadership are striving to provide an environment where we hear the call to discipleship and are nurtured and strengthened in our response and growth. This will involve ongoing discernment, conversation, and commitment and we have much work to do. You will hear more.

Neighbors Helping Neighbors

The Palm Sunday breakfast that is held at the St. Scholastica church building is fast approaching. There is a bit of controversy for some that the proceeds go to support the St. Scholastica Cemetery. The cemetery board helped start the breakfast years ago and has become dependent on it. St. Scholastica is not its own parish anymore and neither is St. John. We are merged and are now the Western Catholic Community. In these past six years being at the St. Scholastica site, I have seen people die or get too old to help. Some new come in, but they don't have enough labor to pull it off. Even if they could squeak by, they shouldn't because everyone gets worn down. There just aren't as many people from St. Scholastica anymore. There are far more people from the other churches that were involved in the merger. So I beg the question, can't we help a neighbor out?

The former St. Scholastica has a core group of people who like to help out with certain jobs. Maybe this could be looked at. They also have a handful of people who are used to leading it and it is fairly complicated and well put together. Rightly or wrongly, we have normally chosen a family from the former St. Scholastica to lead the breakfast. The breakfast is one of the heartiest of the year, yet very profitable because former St. Scholastica parishioners mainly donate the food. We tried a sign-up sheet at St. John's and it never caught on. This coming breakfast we didn't bring it back and forth; perhaps if there is interest, we can try it in the future.

Down the road, these cemeteries will have to work together for survival. They may have to invest their money together in order that perpetual care may continue. So helping one cemetery is really helping all the cemeteries. If you are asked to help at the breakfast, please step forward. We have the potential to do so many great things together. When Fr. Elgar and Fr. Roedel were around, each church was their own individual parish. Whether we want to go back to that or not is not an issue, we are together for good. So let us help each other out for we are more than neighbors; we are family.

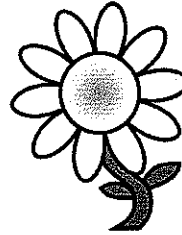
Prayer Shawl Ministry

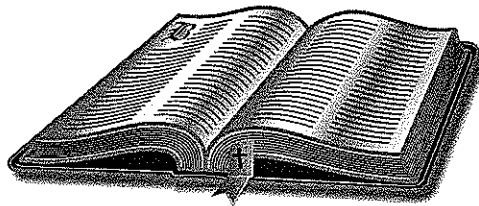

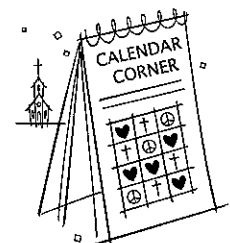
