Life Teen Mission Trip 2017 ** Lafayette Louisiana

Dear parishioners,

We have nearly 50 people going to Louisiana in June to help a community in dire need. In August of 2016, the state of Louisiana had roughly 7 trillion gallons of water rain down in the span of one week. One area saw more than 2 1/2 feet of rain in less than a day. The flooding caused an estimated \$8.7 billion in damages, and more than 100,000 homes were damaged in this natural disaster. Rebuild efforts are still ongoing in 2017, and people in numerous parishes of Louisiana are still desperately in need of help.

Pope Emeritus Benedict said to the young people of the world: "You were not created for comfort but for greatness." Our youth are not looking for someone to offer them an easy life; they are willing to be uncomfortable. Mission trips are life changing because our youth are able to get away and truly disconnect from their busy lives (phones, internet, work, school, sports). When they disconnect and spend time in a new environment, their eyes are opened to the need around them. And guess what? When their eyes are opened they can't be closed. It is a fact that students who attend mission trips are more likely to serve locally here in Door County because of their eye-opening experience on mission trips.

We created mission boards that have 100 squares and you donate the amount of the square you picked. So, if you pick square 3, you pay \$3! Or if you pick square 75, you pay \$75! There is NO limit to the amount of people who pick one square. So, we can have 10 people donate to square 100! (Trip per teen: \$750) Thank you can't even begin to cover how grateful we are for your donations and support. Our youth have been working hard earning money to go--this isn't a free ride for them. It's people like you that make it possible.

Our goal is to fill all 100 squares. That amount would be \$5050! We are giving you another opportunity to Take Stock in our mission! ANY amount is appreciated--honestly, a dollar goes a long way! Please fill out the bottom part of this and send it to Corpus Christi (or drop it off in the collection basket at any parish) if you would like to help us reach our goal. All donations are tax deductible and get recorded at the parish in which you belong. If you become a Stockholder you will receive a thank you card from the trip, and an opportunity to come to our Stockholder's dinner in August so you can hear all about the trip. We also take all names and pray for them by name during our journey.
