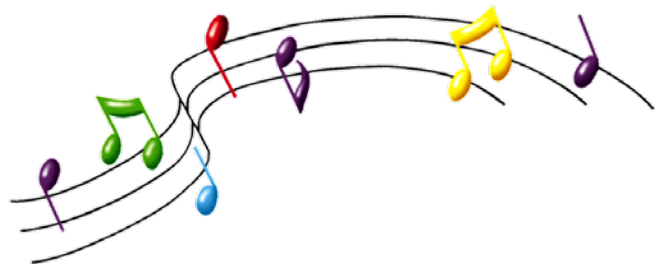

Ordinary Time and Summer

Ordinary Time begins in June for the Church, and we prepare to welcome summer for another season. Perhaps we can look at how we can—how we do—sincerely say “thanks” to our Heavenly Father. Here are a few suggestions from Bill Dodds, OSV:

Go to Mass: it is an act of thanksgiving that we must actively take part in. Praying with others, offering our own private prayers, reverently receiving the Blessed Sacrament, singing, and staying for the closing blessing!

Do what Jesus told us to do: “love one another as I have loved you” (Jn 13:34). How do we do that? Find out by spending some time reading about how Jesus did it. Pray the gospels. Living the Faith—living our gratitude to God—means living the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

Do not put a gift from God in your sock drawer: remember the Parable of the Talents (Mt 25:14-30)? The lesson here is to use what our Heavenly Father gives you! Pay close attention to the talents God has given you, develop them during this season of *Ordinary Time and summer*, and use them to help others.
