**WHY DO WE SAY "AMEN" AT THE END OF SOME PRAYERS?**

In Hebrew, the word "Amen" shares the same root as the word "believe." This root also expresses trustworthiness and faithfulness.

When you read the gospels, you will see that Jesus sometimes used the word "Amen" twice in a row to emphasize the trustworthiness of His teaching. He wanted His listeners to pay special attention.
