### **First Reading: Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48**

St. Peter speaks in the house of Cornelius, a recent convert. Suddenly the Holy Spirit is "poured out" on the listeners, a group of Gentiles, even before their baptisms.

### **Second Reading: I John 4:7-10**

### **Gospel: John 15:9-17**
