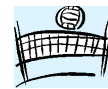

## THE PREFACE

### FAMILY IDEAS

In the Preface at Mass we celebrate that God fulfilled the promise to the people and sent a Savior—Jesus Christ, the Son of God. This promise was fulfilled in a way no one could have expected. God keeps promises to us. We are called to trust always in our God. Nurture an attitude of gratitude in your family:

At the dinner table ask each person to say something for which they are thankful that day. This might be friends, learning something new, someone who helped them, a sunny day, a puppy, or even having pizza for dinner.

Make a “Thank you, God” sign for your home or print off a psalm verse poster from the internet, such as “I give thanks to you, O Lord my God, with my whole heart.” (Psalm 86:12) Frame it and place on a shelf where every family member will see it and remember to give thanks to God.

### FAMILY PRAYER

God of promises, we give you thanks and praise for always keeping your promises to us. We are your people, and you are our God. We know that you are with us in all things. Guide our family to trust always in you and in your love for us. Amen.

### A CALL TO HOLINESS BY POPE FRANCIS.

47. Gnosticism gave way to another heresy, likewise present in our day. As time passed, many came to realize that it is not knowledge that betters us or makes us saints, but the kind of life we lead. But this subtly led back to the old error of the gnostics, which was simply transformed rather than eliminated.

48. The same power that the gnostics attributed to the intellect, others now began to attribute to the human will, to personal effort. This was the case with the pelagians and semi-pelagians. Now it was not intelligence that took the place of mystery and grace, but our human will. It was forgotten that everything “depends not on human will or exertion, but on God who shows mercy” (*Rom 9:16*) and that “he first loved us” (*cf. 1 Jn 4:19*).



### UN LLAMADO A LA SANTIDAD DEL PAPA FRANCISCO.

47. El gnosticismo dio lugar a otra vieja herejía, que también está presente hoy. Con el paso del tiempo, muchos comenzaron a reconocer que no es el conocimiento lo que nos hace mejores o santos, sino la vida que llevamos. El problema es que esto se degeneró sutilmente, de manera que el mismo error de los gnósticos simplemente se transformó, pero no fue

superado.

48. Porque el poder que los gnósticos atribuían a la inteligencia, algunos comenzaron a atribuírselo a la voluntad humana, al esfuerzo personal. Así surgieron los pelagianos y los semipelagianos. Ya no era la inteligencia lo que ocupaba el lugar del misterio y de la gracia, sino la voluntad. Se olvidaba que «todo depende no del querer o del correr, sino de la misericordia de Dios» (*Rm* 9,16) y que «él nos amó primero» (*1 Jn* 4,19).
