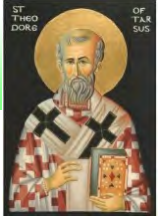

## Praying the Rosary

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the *Apostles' Creed*, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The *Our Father*, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the *Hail Mary* is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. St. Pius V officially added the second part of the *Hail Mary*.

The Mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and the Luminous. The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead one into restful and contemplative prayer related to each Mystery. The Rosary can be said privately or with a group.

During the month of October 2018, Pope Francis has requested "the faithful of all the world to pray that the Holy Mother of God may place the Church beneath her protective mantle: that the Church may be preserved from the attacks of the evil one and at the same time to make her more aware of the faults, the errors and the abuses committed in the present and in the past, and committed to combating without any hesitation, so that evil may not prevail" (Holy See Press Office, September 29, 2018). The Pope also has asked us to add the following prayers when we recite the Rosary:

**Prayer to Mother Mary**  
*We fly to your protection, O holy Mother of God;  
despise not our petitions in our necessities,  
but ever deliver us from all danger,  
O glorious and blessed Virgin.*

**Prayer to St. Michael**  
*Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle;  
be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil.  
May God rebuke him, we humbly pray;  
and you, O prince of the heavenly hosts,  
by the power of God,  
cast down to hell Satan and the other evil spirits,  
who prowl through the world for the ruin of souls. Amen.*
